This Order designates the International Organisation for Migration as an organisation to which Part VIII of the Diplomatic Relations and Immunities Act, 1967 applies.

The purpose of this Order dated 7 March 2002 is to give effect within the State to Article 27 of the Constitution of the International Organisation for Migration, which provides that the Organisation shall enjoy full juridical personality in the territories of each State party to the Constitution.

CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT, 1994 (SECTION 57A) ORDER, 2002.

This Order is made under section 57A (as inserted by section 23 of the Criminal Justice (Theft and Fraud Offences) Act, 2001) of the Criminal Justice Act, 1994 and shall come into operation on 2 April, 2002. The Order designates Nauru as a state that in the opinion of the Minister has not in place adequate procedures for the detection of money laundering.
