HORSE MACKEREL (RESTRICTION ON FISHING) ORDER, 2002.

The effect of this Order is to prohibit fishing for, transhipment or having on board horse mackerel by Irish sea-fishing boats in ICES sub-areas Vb⁽¹⁾, VI, VII, VIII abde, XII and XIV with effect from 4 p.m. on the 21st day of March, 2002. The Order allows Irish vessels to retain on board, land or tranship horse mackerel if the horse mackerel does not exceed 5% by weight of all species held on board, landed or transhipped at any one time from 4 p.m. on the 21st day of March, 2002. (PN. 11342) (Price €0.76).

COD (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 3) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the cod fishery in area VII (excl. VIIa) with effect from the 1st day of April, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 1 tonne of cod during the period of the 1st day of April, 2002 and the 30th day of April, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for cod or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 0.75 tonnes of cod during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of cod. (Pn. 11375) Price €0.76.

MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) ORDER (No. 3), 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in Area VII with effect from the 1st day of April, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 4 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of April, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish (Pn. 11376) Price €0.76.

MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 4) ORDER, 2002.

This order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in Area Vb (EC waters), VI, XII, XIV with effect from the 1st day of April, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 6 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of April, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 3 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish. (Pn. 11377) Price €0.76.

HAKE (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) ORDER (No. 2), 2002.

This Order provides for a continuation of the management regime for the hake fishery in Area VI, VII with effect from the 1st day of April, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of longlines or Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of hake during the period from the 1st day of April, 2002 to the 30th day of April, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for hake by any other method regardless of length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 1 tonne of hake during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of hake. (Pn. 11378) Price €0.76.

WHITING (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 3) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the whiting fishery in Area VII with effect from the 1st day of April, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board more than the following quantities of whiting during the period from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of April, 2002.

(a) 30 tonnes of whiting in sub-area VII (ex VIIa)

(b) 2 tonnes of whiting in sub-area VIIa

subject to the condition that not more than a maximum of 30 tonnes of whiting shall be retained on board or landed in Area VII as a whole. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for whiting or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than the following quantities of whiting during this period;

(a) 21 tonnes of whiting in sub-area VII (ex VIIa)

(b) 1 tonne of whiting in sub-area VIIa

subject to the conditions that not more than a maximum of 21 tonnes of whiting shall be landed or retained on board in Area VII as a whole. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of whiting. (Pn. 11379) Price €0.76.

HADDOCK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 3) ORDER, 2002.

From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 7 tonnes of Haddock during the period from the 1st day of April, 2002 to the 31st day of May, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Haddock or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 3.5 tonnes of Haddock during this period.
