The Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, Mr. Dermot Ahern, T.D. has made the following orders:

S.I. No. 369 of 2002.

HADDOCK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 5) ORDER, 2002.

This Order allows for the fishing, landing or having on board haddock in ICES area VII (excl VIIa), VIII, IX, X (EC waters) with effect from the 1st day of August, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 8 tonnes of Haddock during the period from the 1st day of August, 2002 to the 30th day of September, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Haddock or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 4 tonnes of Haddock during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of Haddock (Pn. 11912) (Price: €0.76).

S.I. No. 370 of 2002.

COD (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 7) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the cod fishery in area VII(excl. VIIa) with effect from the 1st day of August, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 0.5 tonne of cod during the period of the 1st day of August, 2002 and the 31st day of August, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for cod or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 0.25 tonne of cod during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of cod. (Pn 11913) Price (€0.76).

MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 11) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in Area VII with effect from the 1st day of August, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 5 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of August to the 31st day of August, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 2.5 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish. (Pn. 11914) (Price: €0.76)

S.I. No. 372 of 2002.

MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 12) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in Area Vb (EC waters), VI, XII, XIV with effect from the 1st day of August, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 10 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of August to the 31st day of August, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 5 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish. (Pn. 11915) (Price: €0.76)

S.I. No. 373 of 2002.

**HAKE (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND
CONSERVATION) (No. 5) ORDER, 2002.**

This Order provides for a continuation of the management regime for the hake fishery in Area VI, VII with effect from the 1st day of August, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, and fishing by means of longlines or Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 6 tonnes of hake during the period from the 1st day of August to the 30th day of September, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for hake by any other method regardless of length, or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 4 tonnes of hake during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of hake. (Pn. 11916) (Price: €0.76)
