COD (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 11) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the Cod fishery in area VII (excl. VIIa) with effect from the 1st day of December, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 0.5 tonne of Cod during the period from the 1st day of December, 2002 to the 31st day of December, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Cod or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 0.25 tonne of Cod during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of Cod. (Pn. 12372). Price (€0.76)

HADDOCK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 9) ORDER, 2002.

This Order allows for the fishing, landing or having on board Haddock in ICES area VII (excl VIIa), VIII, IX, X (EC waters) with effect from the 1st day of December, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 4 tonnes of Haddock during the period from the 1st day of December, 2002 to the 31st day of December, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Haddock or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of Haddock during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of Haddock. (Pn. 12373). Price (€0.76)

MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 17) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the Monkfish fishery in area VII with effect from the 1st day of December, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 1 tonne of Monkfish during the period from the 1st day of December to the 31st day of December, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 0.5 tonnes of Monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of Monkfish. (Pn. 12374). Price (€0.76)

NORWAY LOBSTER (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 17) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the Norway Lobster fishery in area VII with effect from the 1st day of December, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of Norway Lobster during the period of the 1st day of December, 2002 and the 31st day of December, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Norway Lobster or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 1 tonne of Norway Lobster during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of Norway Lobster. (Pn. 12375). Price (€0.76)

POLLOCK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a continuation of the management regime for the Pollock fishery in area VII with effect from the 1st day of December, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of Pollock during the period from the 1st day of December, 2002 to the 31st day of December, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Pollock by any other method regardless of length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 1 tonne of Pollock during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of Pollock. (Pn. 12377). Price (€0.76)

MEGRIM (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) ORDER, 2002.

THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS (MISCELLANEOUS
PROVISIONS) ACT, 1996 (SECTION 6) POSTAL LEVY
No. 3 ORDER, 2002

The Director of Telecommunications Regulation has made a
Statutory Instrument, under section 6(1) of the
Telecommunications (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1996, (No.
34 of 1996) as amended by the European Communities (Postal
Services) Regulations, 2000 (S.I. No. 310 of 2000).

S.I. No. 549 of 2002 provides for a levy on An Post for the
purpose of meeting expenses properly incurred by the Director
of Telecommunications Regulation in the discharge of her
functions in respect of postal services. The levy will cover the
levy period from 1 July 2002 to 30 June 2003 and for subsequent
levy years.

The Director of Telecommunications Regulation issued a
Response to Consultation 'Levy on Providers of Postal
Services', Document No. 02/105 on Friday 29 November 2002.
This paper is available for download on the ComReg website,
www.ComReg.ie or copies may be obtained by contacting the
office at 01-8049600.

The paper summarises the consultation issues and the views of
respondents with regard to the issues consulted on. The paper
also sets out the Directors position in respect to making a
revised postal levy order for providers of postal services under
the following headings:

- Operation of the levy;
- Persons and Organisations liable to the levy;
- Information to be supplied annually; and
- Adjustments to the amount levied.

The Revised Postal Levy Order will take effect from 1 July 2002
to 30 June 2003 and for subsequent levy years. In making a
revised levy order the most significant factor will be the extent
of the levy imposed on An Post. The revised levy will be
reduced from 0.5% to 0.25% of relevant turnover.

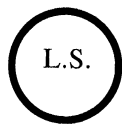
