RETAIL GROCERY AND ALLIED TRADES JOINT  
LABOUR COMMITTEE

Pursuant to Section 43 of the Industrial Relations Act, 1946, the Labour Court hereby gives notice that it has made an Employment Regulation Order (Retail Grocery and Allied Trades Joint Labour Committee) 2002. The Order is effective from 13th December, 2002 and fixes the statutory minimum rates of pay and statutory conditions of employment of workers in relation to whom the Committee operates.
