The Minister for Health and Children has made the following Statutory Instrument.

S.I. No. 547 of 2002.

MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCES (INCREASED PAYMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002.

The effect of these Regulations is to increase, in respect of the week commencing 2nd December, 2002 the maximum weekly rate of maintenance allowance payable under section 44 of the Health Act, 1947 by a sum equal to one hundred per cent of that amount or €30, whichever is the greater.

HEALTH (IN-PATIENT CHARGES) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) REGULATIONS, 2002.

These Regulations amend the Health (In-Patient Charges) Regulations, 1987 and 2002 by raising the daily charge for in-patient services from €36 to €40 and by raising the maximum amount payable in any period of twelve consecutive months from €360 to €400. The usual exemptions, which include medical card holders and hardship provision shall continue to apply. The revised charge comes into effect on 1 January, 2003.

Landowners have also been informed of procedures for objecting (on scientific grounds) to the designation proposals and have also been provided with details of the compensation provisions available. Other landowners and land users who believe that they should have been notified will be provided with documentation on request.

Objections or representations with respect to the proposals received within three months will be taken into consideration before any Natural Heritage Area order is made under the Act.
