EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (AMENDMENT OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS ACT, 1876) REGULATIONS, 2002.

These regulations give effect to Council Directive 86/609/EEC regarding the protection of animals used for experimental and other scientific purposes. They amend The Cruelty to Animals Act, 1876 which prohibits painful experiments on living animals except subject to the restrictions imposed by the Act.

The regulations also revoke the European Communities (Amendment of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1876) Regulations, 1994.
