Refugee Act, 1996

The Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the above Act has made Regulations entitled:

S.I. No. 571 of 2002.

REFUGEE ACT, 1996 (APPEALS) REGULATIONS, 2002.

The Regulations revoke and replace the Refugee Act, 1996 (Appeals) Regulations, 2000 (S.I. No. 342 of 2000). The Regulations supplement in detail the procedures set out in section 16 of the Refugee Act, 1996 in relation to the determination by the Refugee Appeals Tribunal of appeals against recommendations of the Refugee Applications Commissioner on applications for recognition as a refugee.

S.I. No. 583 of 2002.

COD (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 12) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the cod fishery in area VII (excl VIIa) with effect from the 1st day of December 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 0.5 tonne of cod during the period of the 1st day of January, 2003 and the 31st day of January, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for cod or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 0.25 tonne of cod during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of cod. (PN 12536) Price (€0.76).

COMMON SOLE (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 7) ORDER, 2002.

The Order allows Irish sea-fishing boats to land or tranship common sole caught in ICES Divisions VIIIf and VIIg provided that

boats fishing by means of beam trawls — the common sole may not exceed 0.5% by weight of the total catch of quota species landed or transhipped on any occasion.

boats fishing by means other than beam trawls — the common sole may not exceed 0.5% by weight of the total catch of all quota species landed or transhipped on any occasion. (PN. 12537) (Price €0.76).

HADDOCK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 10) ORDER, 2002.

This Order allows for the fishing, landing or having on board haddock in ICES area VII (excl VIIa), VIII, IX, X (EC waters) with effect from the 1st day of January, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 3 tonnes of Haddock during the period from the 1st day of January, 2003 to the 31st day of January, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Haddock or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 1 tonnes of Haddock during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of Haddock. (PN. 12538) (€0.76).

HAKE (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) ORDER, (No. 8), 2002.

This Order provides for a continuation of the management regime for the hake fishery in Area VI, VII with effect from the 1st day of January, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of longlines or Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 1 tonne of hake during the period from the 1st day of January, 2003 to the 31st day of January, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for hake by any other method regardless of length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 0.5 tonne of hake during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of hake. (PN. 12539) (€0.76).

HERRING (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 4) ORDER, 2002.

The effect of this Order is to permit the fishing for, transhipment, landing or having on board herring by Irish sea-fishing boats, duly licensed, and between VIaS and VIIbc with effect on the 5th day of January, 2003. (PN. 12540) (€0.51).

MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 19) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in Area VII with effect from the 1st day of January, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of January to the 31st day of January, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 1 tonnes of monkfish during this period. The Monk (Fisheries Management and Conservation) (No. 18) Order, 2002 (S.I. No. 564 of 2002) is revoked from 1st day of January, 2003. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish (PN. 12541) (€0.76).

MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 20) ORDER 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in Area Vb (EC waters), VI, XII, XIV with effect from the 1st day of January, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 6 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of January to the 31st day of January, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 3 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish. (PN. 12542) (€0.76).

DEEP SEA FISH STOCKS (LICENSING) ORDER, 2002.

The effect of this Order is to set up a licensing regime for the fishing of quotas allocated to Ireland of black scabbard fish, greater silver smelt, tusk, roundnose grenadier, orange roughy, blue ling, ling, red seabream and redfish. The Order will be effective from 1 January, 2003. (PN. 12572) (Price €2.54: postage extra).

HORSE MACKEREL (LICENSING) ORDER, 2002.

The effect of this Order is to extend the requirement for certain Irish sea-fishing boats to be duly licensed under the Order to fish for, tranship or have on board horse mackerel. The Order is extended to all RSW vessels and vessels having bulk storage capacity. (PN. 12573) (Price €1.22, postage extra).

HERRING (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 5) ORDER, 2002.

This Order prohibits fishing for, transshipping, landing or having on board herring by Irish sea-fishing boats in ICES Divisions, Vb (EC waters), V1a north of 56'00 and in that part of VIa which is situated west of 07'00'W and north of 55'00'N, excluding the Clyde and VIb, with effect from midnight on the 20th day of December 2002 to the 1st day of January, 2003.
