Now therefore the Minister for Health and Children, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7 of the Misuse of Drugs Act, 1977 and section 8 of that Act (as substituted by section 3 of the Misuse of Drugs Act, 1984) hereby gives in respect of the said Dr. Seamus Hanratty the following special direction:

Dr. Seamus Hanratty of Lisheen, Castleknock Road, Dublin 15, is hereby prohibited from prescribing, administering or supplying or authorising the administration or supply of all controlled drugs listed in Schedules 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Misuse of Drugs Regulations, 1988 (S.I. No. 328 of 1988) as amended by the Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) Regulations, 1993 (S.I. No. 342 of 1993).
