**COMPANY LAW ENFORCEMENT ACT, 2001
(WINDING-UP AND INSOLVENCY PROVISIONS)
(COMMENCEMENT) ORDER, 2002.**

Mary Harney, Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 2 of the Company Law Enforcement Act, 2001 (No. 28 of 2001) ("Act"), has made an Order entitled as above.

This Order provides for the commencement of Part 5 (other than section 47) of the Company Law Enforcement Act, 2001 on 1 June, 2002. The Order provides for the commencement of section 56, only insofar as it relates to:

- (a) liquidators who are appointed on or after 1st June, 2002 or
- (b) liquidators who were appointed on or after 1 July, 2001 and before 1 June, 2002, where in respect of the company to which the liquidator was appointed an order has not been made under section 249(1) of the Companies Act, 1963 or where the meetings required under section 273(1) of the Companies Act, 1963 have not been held.
