The Minister for the Marine and Natural Resources, Mr. Frank Fahey, T.D., has made an Order under Section 2 of the Merchant Shipping (Light Duties) Act, 1983 entitled as above.

The Order revokes and replaces the Merchant Shipping (Light Dues) Order, 1997, as amended. It provides for increases, of approximately, 7%, in light dues applicable to vessels calling to ports within the State with effect from 1st April, 2002 and introduces a 40,000 NRT tonnage ceiling, which results in a €22,400 maximum voyage charge.
