Notice of Intention to make the County Borough of Limerick (Prohibition on the Distribution to the Public of Advertising Material) Bye-Laws, 2001.

NOTICE is hereby given by The Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of Limerick, having offices at City Hall, Limerick, the Local Authority for the County Borough of Limerick (hereinafter called Limerick Corporation) that Limerick Corporation have by virtue of sub-section (1) of Section 21 of the Litter Pollution Act, 1997 and in exercise of every other power in that behalf it enabling power to make Bye-Laws, where it deems it necessary for the purpose of preventing the creation of litter, prohibiting of regulating the distribution to the public of advertising material or specified categories of advertising material and NOTICE is hereby further given that sub-section (2) of the said Section 21 of the Litter Pollution Act, 1997 is to the effect that bye-laws under said sub-section (1) of the said Section shall not apply to the distribution of advertising material by means of a direct delivery to a place having an address, or the distribution of advertising material relating to a presidential election within the meaning of the Presidential Elections Act, 1993 a general election or a bye-election, within the meaning, in each case, of the Electoral Act, 1992, a local election within the meaning of the Local Government Act, 1994, a referendum, within the meaning of the Referendum Act, 1994, or an election of representatives to the Assembly of the European Communities and NOTICE is hereby further given that sub-section (3) of the said Section 21 of the Litter Pollution Act, 1997 is to the effect that Bye-Laws under sub-section (1) of the said Section shall be made in accordance with and shall be construed for the purposes of its enforcement as if it were made under Part VII of the Local Government Act, 1994.

NOW TAKE NOTICE that Limerick Corporation, deeming it necessary for the purpose of preventing the creation of litter, in exercise of the said powers vested in them and in exercise of every other power in that behalf it enabling propose to make the County Borough of Limerick (Prohibition on the Distribution to the Public of Advertising Material) Bye-Laws 2001.

The said proposed Bye-Laws contain a prohibition therein to the effect that a person shall not distribute or attempt to distribute or cause to be distributed advertising material to any person or otherwise to a member or members of the public in:—

- (a) a public road, roadway, footpath, footway, or road, or
- (b) the following Public Parks under the control or management of Limerick Corporation—
 - (i) the Peoples Park situate at Pery Square,
 - (ii) the Arthur's Quay Park situate at Arthur's Quay,
 - (iii) the Terence Albert O'Brien Park situate at Clare Street,
 - (iv) the Shelbourne Park situate at Shelbourne Road,

(v) the Barrington's Pier Park or

- (c) any Public Open Space under the control or management of Limerick Corporation.

However, the said proposed Bye-Laws contain a provision therein to the effect that the aforementioned prohibition shall not apply to the distribution of advertising material by means of a direct delivery to a place having an address, or to the distribution of advertising material relating to a presidential election within the meaning of the Presidential Elections Act, 1993, a general election or a bye-election, within the meaning, in each case, of the Electoral Act, 1992, a local election within the meaning of the Local Government Act, 1994, a referendum, within the meaning of the Referendum Act, 1994, or an election of representatives to the Assembly of the European Communities, or the distribution of advertising material by or on behalf of a person, body, body corporate, unincorporated body of persons, community group, special interest group or organisation for educational or information purposes only relating to the promotion of the interests of the local community or relating to matters of public interest provided that such advertising material contains written or printed thereon the name and address of such person, body, body corporate, unincorporated body of persons, community group, special interest group or organisation, as the case may be.

The said proposed Bye-Laws further contain a provision therein to the effect that such Bye-Laws shall apply to the area comprising the County Borough of Limerick and further contain provisions therein with regard to Members of the Garda Síochána and authorised persons in the enforcement of the Bye-Laws.

The said proposed Bye-Laws also contain a provision therein to the effect that a person who contravenes a provision of the Bye-Laws shall be guilty of an offence under and by virtue of Section 40 of the Local Government Act, 1994 and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding €1,904.61.

- (1) A copy of the proposed Bye-Laws will be available for public inspection free of charge at the Environment Dept., City Hall, Limerick during normal office hours for a period of five weeks from the date of publication of this Notice.
