COD (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 10) ORDER, 2002.

This Order provides for a management regime for the cod fishery in area VII (excl VIIa) with effect from the 1st day of November, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 0.5 tonne of cod during the period of the 1st day of November, 2002 and the 30th day of November, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for cod or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 0.25 tonne of cod during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of cod. (Pn. 12233) Price (€0.76)

S.I. No. 489 of 2002.

HADDOCK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 8) ORDER, 2002.

This Order allows for the fishing, landing or having on board haddock in ICES area VII (excl VIIa), VIII, IX, X (EC waters) with effect from the 1st day of November, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 4 tonnes of Haddock during the period from the 1st day of November, 2002 to the 30th day of November, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for Haddock or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of Haddock during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of Haddock. (Pn. 12235) (Price: €0.76)

**MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND  
CONSERVATION) (No. 16) ORDER, 2002.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in Area VII with effect from the 1st day of November, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 4 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of November to the 30th day of November, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish. (Pn. 12234) Price: (€0.76)

**HAKE (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND  
CONSERVATION) (No. 7) ORDER, 2002.**

This Order provides for a continuation of the management regime for the hake fishery in Area VI, VII with effect from the 1st day of November, 2002. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of longlines or Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 8 tonnes of hake during the period from the 1st day of November, 2002 to the 31st day of December, 2002. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for hake by any other method regardless of length, or a person on board such boat, may not have on board or land more than 6 tonnes of hake during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of hake. The Hake (Fisheries Management and Conservation) (No. 6) Order, 2002 (S.I. No. 455 of 2002) is revoked from the 1st day of November 2002. (Pn. 12236) Price (€0.76)

VESTING ORDER

Thursday the Tenth day of October Two Thousand and Two

Estate of the MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE AND FOOD  
(formerly the Estates the Titles of which are set forth in the First Row of the Third Schedule hereto)

County of Westmeath

IT IS ORDERED by the Minister for Agriculture and Food pursuant to the powers conferred by the Land Purchase Acts that the lands and hereditaments comprised in the several holdings described in Row 4 of the Third Schedule hereto and respectively in the occupation of the several tenants named above the same holdings in Row 3 of the said Schedule together with the easements, rights and appurtenances specified in the First Schedule hereto DO VEST and the same are hereby vested in the said several tenants in fee-simple excepting and reserving thereout such mines and mineral rights and such easements and other rights as are specified in the Second Schedule hereto, subject to and charged with repayment to the said Minister of the respective advances specified in Row 6 of the Third Schedule hereto below the names of the said several tenants with interest thereon by means of the respective annuities specified in Row 7 of the said Schedule below the said advances as by the Land Purchase Acts is provided and further subject, and subject to such other burdens and rights and charges as may lawfully affect the same respectively and it is further ORDERED and DECLARED by the Minister for Agriculture and Food as is set forth in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

Exceptions, Reservations and Servient Rights

The easements and rights mentioned in Section 34(1) of the Land Law (Ireland) Act, 1896, and in addition to or included therein the following exceptions, reservations, easements and rights, that is to say:—

1. The exclusive right of mining and taking minerals, within the meaning of the Irish Land Act, 1903, and of digging and searching for the same, in so far as the same are not otherwise excepted and reserved in this Order reserved to and vested in the State.
2. The Sporting Rights in so far as the same are not otherwise excepted and reserved, reserved to the owner or owners thereof.
3. The Fishing Rights and Fisheries, if any, other than the Shannon Fisheries reserved to the Central Fisheries Board.
- 3a The Shannon Fisheries within the meaning of the Shannon Fisheries Acts, 1935 and 1938 not affected by this Order.
