NEW PROPOSALS FOR *EIRCOM* RETAIL PRICE CAP

Consultation Paper 02/96

The Telecoms Regulator Etain Doyle is proposing to replace the current retail price cap on *eircom* from CPI-8 to a band between CPI-2 to CPI-0. This will mean that *eircom* cannot raise the average price to the consumer of telecommunication services included in the control by more than the rate of inflation (CPI-0) or 2% less than the rate of inflation (CPI-2).

While the current Price Cap has seen a reduction in *eircom* call charges over the past few years, the Regulator now believes that relaxing the price cap will allow other operators compete more effectively with *eircom*.

To protect the most vulnerable low volume user, *eircom* has proposed that it would provide €5 worth of free national/local calls for €22.50 per month, with no line rental charge. If a customer exceeded the free call allowance, they would pay local/national call charges at double the standard rate. The Regulator is particularly anxious to receive feedback from Consumer and other representative groups about this proposal which would replace the current vulnerable low user calculation method.

Members of the public, Consumer and Business Groups are encouraged to respond to the Regulator's proposals before the 10th January 2003.
