- (c) To amend the Charters and Letters Patent by removing any monetary limitation regarding the annual rental value of land enjoyed by the College.

(i) To amend the Charters and Letters Patent so as to enable the College to promote research and facilitate quality patient care in surgery medicine, nursing, radiology, pharmacy, anaesthesiology, physiotherapy, dentistry and other fields of discipline and to collaborate with others to further the interest of the College and to deal with property and receive gifts consistent with the Charters, Letters Patent and the 1965 Act.

(j) To enable the College to establish faculties, colleges, centres and schools in medicine, nursing, radiology, pharmacy, dentistry, physiotherapy and other disciplines.
