COMMUNICATIONS REGULATION ACT 2002
 (ESTABLISHMENT DAY) ORDER 2002.

The establishment of the Commission for Communications Regulation will have the effect of dissolving the Office of the Director of Telecommunications Regulation and transferring the functions of the Director to the new Commission under the Act.
