## EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (CONTROL OF EXPORTS OF DUAL-USE ITEMS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002.

The Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, Ms Mary Harney T.D., in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 3 of the European Communities Act, 1972 (No. 27 of 1972), has made Regulations amending the European Communities (Control of Exports of Dual-Use Items) Regulations, 2000 (S.I. No. 317 of 2000) which provides effective control of exports of dual-use items (items which may be used for both civil and military purposes) as provided for in Council Regulation (EC) No. 1334/2000 of 22 June, 2000, and to provide for penalties of the prohibition. The purpose of the amending Regulations is to reflect amendments made to Council Regulation (EC) No. 1334/2000.
