The Director of Telecommunications Regulation has made a Statutory Instrument, under the Telecommunications (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1996 (No. 34 of 1996).

S.I. No. 467 provides for the amendment of the Wireless Telegraphy (Fixed Wireless point to multi-point access licence) Regulations, 1999 (S.I. No. 287 of 1999) under which licences are issued to keep and have possession of apparatus for wireless telegraphy for the purpose of using FWPMA for the provision of the telecommunications access networks and services. The Regulation provide for an amendment of the fee structure for apparatus in the 24.5-26.5 GHz frequency band.
