PROHIBITION ON THE HARVESTING OF OYSTERS

The Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, Mr. Dermot Ahern, TD, in pursuance of the powers available to him under the European Communities (Live Bivalve Molluscs) (Health Conditions for Production and Placing on the Market) Regulations, 1996, as amended by the European Communities (Live Bivalve Molluscs) (Health Conditions for Production and Placing on the Market) (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, has made a prohibition on the harvesting of oysters in the **North Channel of Cork Harbour, Co. Cork**, effective from 15 October, 2002.

The Minister has decreed that no depuration or re-immersion of shellfish should take place at the approved depuration centres in the area during the prohibition.

Scientific monitoring of the area is ongoing and the withdrawal of the prohibition will be published as and when the Minister decides that it is suitable to harvest oysters from the area affected.
