Notice is hereby given that the Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform has made an Order entitled as above. This Order brings section 4(2)(c) of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2001 into operation on 4 November, 2002.

Section 4(2)(c) provides for the presumption of corruption where proceedings are being taken under the Act against a person exercising any functions of a Minister or an officer of a Minister or any other person employed by, or acting on behalf of, or a member of a body that is part of the public administration of the State under the Planning and Development Act, 2000 where there is proof that he or she received money or other benefit from a person who has an interest in the way those functions are exercised.

The remainder of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2001 came into operation on 26 November, 2001.
