S.I. No. 416 of 2002.

## **MERCHANT SHIPPING (LOAD LINES) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2002**

This Order exempts from the provisions of the Merchant Shipping (Load Lines) Act, 1968, certain classes of ships under 80 tons register engaged solely in the coastal trade.

## **EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (SAFETY OF FISHING VESSELS) REGULATIONS 2002**

The Regulations replace the European Communities (Fishing Vessel Safety) Regulations 1998 (S.I. No. 549 of 1998) which implemented EC Directive 97/70/EC and give effect to Commission Directive 2002/35/EC. The Regulations give further effect to a harmonised safety regime for fishing vessels of 24 metres in length and over.

## **FISHING VESSELS (SAFETY PROVISIONS) REGULATIONS 2002**

These Regulations replace the Fishing Vessels (Safety Provisions) Regulations 1998 (S.I. No. 550 of 1998) which implemented EC Directive 97/70/EC, and also give effect to Commission Directive 2002/35/EC. The Regulations set down safety standards for fishing vessels of 24 metres and over insofar as the Torremolinos Convention 1977 as modified by the 1993 Protocol refers.

## **EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (PASSENGER SHIPS) REGULATIONS 2002**

These Regulations replace the Merchant Shipping (Passenger Ships) Regulations 1998 (S.I. No. 548 of 1998) which implemented Council Directive 98/18/EC and also give effect to Commission Directive 2002/25/EC. The Regulations introduce a uniform level of safety of life and property on new and existing passenger ships and high speed craft.

## **MERCHANT SHIPPING (SAFE MANNING, HOURS OF WORK AND WATCHKEEPING) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2002**

The Merchant Shipping (Safe Manning, Hours of Work and Watchkeeping) Regulations 1998 (S.I. No. 551 of 1998) are amended in order to include a definition of "international voyage" and to allow for a change in wording in Regulation 5(1), which extends the application of Regulation 5 (Safe Manning Document) to passenger ships on international voyages.
