EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (FOODSTUFFS INTENDED FOR PARTICULAR NUTRITIONAL USES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002.

The Amendment specifies the date of effect of regulations omitted in error from the previous Statutory Instrument No. 379 of 2002 European Communities (Foodstuffs Intended for Particular Nutritional Uses) Regulations, 2002.

The Group of foodstuffs for particular nutritional uses to which these Regulations refer and for which specific Directives exist and which are referred to in Annex 1 of Directive 89/398/EEC are:

- (a) Infant formulae and follow-on-formulae (S.I. No. 243 of 1998),
- (b) Processed cereal-based foods and baby foods for infants and young children (S.I. No. 142 of 2000),
- (c) Food intended for use in energy-restricted diets for weight reduction (S.I. No. 242 of 1998), and
- (d) Dietary foods for special medical purposes (S.I. No. 64 of 2001).

EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (SUSPENDING THE
PLACING ON THE MARKET, THE IMPORTATION AND
THE USE IN MANUFACTURE OF JELLY
CONFECTIONERY CONTAINING THE FOOD
ADDITIVE E 425 KONJAC) REGULATIONS, 2002.

Directive 95/2/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 February on food additives other than colours and Sweeteners authorised in its Annex IV the use of the food additive E 425 konjac in foodstuffs under certain conditions. However with recent information provided by member states the Commission concluded that jelly mini-cups containing E 425 konjac constitute a life-threatening risk. In addition to their shape and size, the chemical and physical properties of konjac are the cause for jelly mini-cups to constitute a serious risk to human health.
