S.I. No. 100 of 2003.

### **HORSE MACKEREL (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) ORDER 2003.**

The effect of this Order is to prohibit fishing for, transhipment or having on board horse mackerel by Irish sea-fishing boats in ICES sub-areas Vb<sup>(1)</sup>, VI, VII, VIII abde, XII and XIV with effect from midnight on the 19th day of March, 2003. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, an Irish sea-fishing boat may have horse mackerel on board and land or tranship horse mackerel in the specified area if the horse mackerel were taken in the course of fishing for other species, and were inextricably mixed with catches of other species and did not exceed 10 per cent by weight of the total catch. **BLUE WHITING (PROHIBITION ON FISHING) ORDER  
2003.**

This Order prohibits fishing for, transshipment, landing or having on board blue whiting by Irish sea-fishing boats in ICES Division V, VI, VII, XII and XIV with effect from midnight on the 19th day of March, 2003. (Pn. 12960) (Price €0.76).

**COD (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND  
CONSERVATION) (No. 5) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the cod fishery in area VIIa with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than 5 tonnes of cod during the period of the 1st day of April, 2003 to the 30th day of April, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for cod or a person on board such boat may not have or retain on board or land more than 2.5 tonnes of cod during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of cod. (Pn. 12962) (Price €0.76).

**COD (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND  
CONSERVATION) (No. 6) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the cod fishery in area VII (excl VIIa) with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than 1 tonne of cod during the period of the 1st day of April, 2003 to the 30th day of April, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for cod or a person on board such boat may not have or retain on board or land more than 0.75 tonnes of cod during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of cod. (PN. 12963) (Price €0.76).

**HADDOCK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND  
CONSERVATION) (No. 3) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the haddock fishery in area VII with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than the following quantities of haddock during the period from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of April, 2003.

- (a) 4 tonnes of haddock in sub-area VII (ex VIIa)
- (b) 1 tonne of haddock in sub-area VIIa

subject to the condition that not more than a maximum of 4 tonnes of haddock shall be retained on board or landed in Area VII as a whole. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for haddock or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than the following quantities of haddock during this period:

- (a) 2 tonnes of haddock in sub-area VII (ex VIIa)
- (b) 0.5 tonne of haddock in sub-area VIIa

subject to the conditions that not more than a maximum of 2 tonnes of haddock shall be landed or retained on board in Area VII as a whole. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of haddock. (Pn. 12964) (Price €0.76).

**WHITING (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND  
CONSERVATION) (No. 4) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the whiting fishery in area VIIa with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of Scottish fly seines or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than the following quantities of whiting during the period from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of April, 2003.

- 1 tonne of whiting in sub-area VIIa

All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for whiting or a person on board such boat may not have or retain on board or land more than the following quantities of whiting during this period:

- (b) 0.5 tonne of whiting in sub-area VIIa

It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transshipment operations of whiting. (PN. 12965) (Price €0.76).

S.I. No. 108 of 2003.

**MEGRIM (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 2) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the Megrim fishery in area VII with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than 6 tonnes of megrim during the period from the 1st day of April, 2003 to the 30th day of April, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for megrim or a person on board such boat may not have or retain on board or land more than 3 tonnes of megrim during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of megrim. (Pn. 12967) (Price €0.76).

**MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 3) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in area Vb (EC waters), VI, XII, XIV with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not retain or have on board or land more than 4 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of April, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not retain or have on board or land more than 2 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish. (Pn. 12968) (Price €0.76).

**MONK (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 4) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the monkfish fishery in area VII with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length, or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than 3 tonnes of monkfish during the period from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of April, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for monkfish or a person on board such boat may not have or retain on board or land more than 1.5 tonnes of monkfish during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of monkfish. (Pn. 12969) (Price €0.76).

S.I. No. 107 of 2003.

**HAKE (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 2) ORDER 2003.**

This Order provides for a management regime for the hake fishery in Area VI, VII with effect from the 1st day of April, 2003. From that date, an Irish sea-fishing boat equal to or greater than 55 feet in length and fishing by means of longlines or Scottish fly seines, or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than 3 tonne of hake during the period from the 1st day of April, 2003 to the 30th day of April, 2003. All other Irish sea-fishing boats fishing for hake by any other method regardless of length, or a person on board such boat, may not have or retain on board or land more than 1.5 tonnes of hake during this period. It is prohibited to tranship or to engage in transhipment operations of hake. (Pn. 12966) (Price €0.76).
