EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (SAFETY OF FISHING VESSELS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2003.

The Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, Mr. Dermot Ahern, T.D., has made the above Regulations. The Regulations amend the European Communities (Safety of Fishing Vessels) Regulations 2002 by substituting the wording in Regulations 3, 4, 5 and 7 in order to clarify the requirements of Directive 97/70/EC on setting up a harmonised safety regime for fishing vessels of 24 metres in length and over. (Pn. 12886) (Price €0.76).
