The Minister of State at the Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment has made the following Statutory Instruments:

S.I. No. 624 of 2002.

DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES (RETAIL AND PRIVATE PETROLEUM STORES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2002.

These Regulations provide for the amendment of the Dangerous Substances (Retail and Private Petroleum Stores) Regulations, 1979, as previously amended by the Dangerous Substances (Retail and Private Petroleum Stores) (Amendment) Regulations, 1988, and the Dangerous Substances (Retail and Private Petroleum Stores) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999, and the Dangerous Substances (Retail and Petroleum Stores) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001. Under the Regulations, as adapted by section 29 of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act, 1989 (No. 7 of 1989), a retail and private petroleum store requires to be licensed by the local or harbour authority or, where the store is owned by such authority, by the National Authority for Occupational Safety and Health.

The Regulations as amended, inter alia, provide for safety requirements in certain circumstances for petrol filling stations, constructed before the 1979 Regulations commenced, to enable them to be licensed to operate until 31 December, 2004. Safety controls on management and operations are maintained.
