The rule makes provision for Doctors who were registered in a temporary capacity before the introduction of the Temporary Registration Assessment Scheme (TRAS) to apply for full registration without having to undergo the TRAS. In addition the rule now allow for doctors who hold temporary registration in excess of 2 years to apply for full registration. Provision is also made for relevant experience to be taken account of in applications for full registration.
