FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, 1997

I, Paul Appleby, Director of Corporate Enforcement and head of the Office of the Director of Corporate Enforcement — a public body within the meaning of the Freedom of Information Act 1997 — in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 of that Act, hereby delegate:—

- (a) To officers specified in Part I of the First Schedule, the functions specified in Part II of the First Schedule;
- (b) To officers specified in Part I of the Second Schedule, the functions specified in Part II of the Second Schedule.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Part I: The Delegates
