HERRING (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 3) ORDER 2003.

This Order prohibits fishing for, transshipping, landing or having on board herring by Irish sea-fishing boats in a geographical area bounded by the South and West coasts of Ireland and a line sequentially joining the following co-ordinates:

- South Coast of Ireland at Longitude 9°00'W
- Latitude 51°15'N, Longitude 9°00'W
- Latitude 51°15'N, Longitude 11°00'W
- Latitude 52°30'N, Longitude 11°00'W
- The West Coast of Ireland at Latitude 52°30'N

with effect from the 7th day of November 2003 to the 22nd day of November 2003.

TO WHOM IT CONCERNS
