**COMPANIES (AUDITING AND ACCOUNTING) ACT**  
**2003 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDER 2004.**

Mary Harney, Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 2 of the Companies (Auditing and Accounting) Act 2003 (No. 44 of 2003), has made an Order entitled as above. The Order sets out the commencement dates for certain provisions of the Act, in three stages.

The 6th day of April, 2004 if fixed as the day on which Part I (Section 1 to 3) and Sections 52, 53(a), (c), (d) and (e), 54, 55, 56, and 57 and Schedule 2 (other than the amendments at item 1 to sections 115(6) and 128(4) of the Companies Act 1963 and the amendments at item 9 to the Companies Act 1990) shall come into operation.

The Order appoints 1st day of July, 2004 as the day on which section 53(b) shall come into operation.

The Order appoints 17th day of May, 2004 as the day on which Section 46 and designated provisions of Section 47 of the Act shall come into operation.
