REFUGEE ACT (SECTION 22) (AMENDMENT) ORDER
2004.

The Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform has made an order entitled as above.

The Order amends the Refugee Act 1996 (Section 22) Order 2003 (S.I. No. 423 of 2003), which puts in place the arrangements necessary in the State to give full effect to Council Regulation (EC) No. 343/2003¹. That Council Regulation sets out the rules and procedures for determining which member state of the European Union is responsible for dealing with an asylum application made in one of them. The amendment effected by this Order provides that where a person to be transferred is detained pending transfer, the detention is in a place prescribed for the detention of persons being removed from the State under Section 5 of the Immigration Act 2003.
