DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (IMPORTATION OF
SHEEP) ORDER 2004.

The Minister for Agriculture and Food has made an order, entitled as above which Revokes the Diseases of Animals Act 1966 (Foot-and-Mouth Disease) (Importation of Sheep) Order 2001 (S.I. No. 364 of 2001), makes it an offence to import, have, slaughter, sell or supply a sheep imported in contravention of an import licence, of a General Authorisation issued by the Minister, and requires the owner, operator or person in charge of a slaughter plant at which imported sheep are to be slaughtered to give 24 hours prior notification of the importation to the Veterinary Inspector in charge at that slaughterhouse.
