SEA FISHERIES (CONSERVATION AND RATIONAL EXPLOITATION OF HAKE) REGULATIONS 2004.

(Prn: 3962)

These Regulations transpose into Irish law the provisions of Council Regulation (EC) No. 811/2004 establishing measures for the recovery of the Northern hake stock. It determines notification arrangements (4 hours advance notification required) and designated ports for the landing of quantities of hake in excess of 2 tonnes. The Regulation shall come into operation on 6 December 2004.
