**BRUCELLOSIS IN CATTLE (GENERAL PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT ORDER 2003.)**

The Minister for Agriculture and Food has made an Order entitled as above to come into effect on 18 December 2003. This Order requires the approval of a veterinary inspector to carry out a herd test for brucellosis; removes the statutory basis for the notice restricting and de-restricting a holding for brucellosis; makes it discretionary on a veterinary inspector to tag and punch reactors and gives a derogation from the 30-day premovement test for eligible male animals, viz. entire male animals aged 12 months or over, moving from a farm direct to an approved Assembly Centre for export for slaughter to a country not requiring a premovement test for brucellosis.

**EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (WORKERS ON BOARD SEA-GOING FISHING VESSELS) (ORGANISATION OF WORKING TIME) REGULATIONS 2003.**

The purpose of these Regulations is to bring into force in Ireland the measures necessary to comply with Directive 98/5/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 February, 1998 to facilitate practice of the profession of a lawyer on a permanent basis in a Member State other than that in which the qualification was obtained and with related instruments applying to the other Member States of the European Economic Area and to Switzerland. For this purpose, provision is made for the registration of such lawyers, their professional activities, conduct and discipline and, subject to certain conditions, their admission into the professions of barrister and solicitor.
