MERCHANT SHIPPING (PASSENGER BOAT)
 (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2003.

The Minister for Communications, Marine and Natural Resources Mr. Dermot Ahern, T.D., has made the above Regulations. These Regulations amend the Merchant Shipping (Passenger Boat) Regulations 2002 and the Merchant Shipping (Passenger Boat) (Amendment) Regulations 2002 in relation to the definition of an “existing passenger boat” and clarify the requirements applicable to existing passenger boats.
