**MACKEREL (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) ORDER, 2004.**

This Order prohibits, with effect from midnight on 30 April 2004, fishing for, transshipment or having on board mackerel by Irish sea-fishing boats of length greater than or equal to 55 feet in ICES sub-areas and divisions, IIa, IVa, Vb, VI, VII, VIIIa, b, d, e, XII and XIV. This fishery has been closed with effect from midnight on 30 April 2004, subject to allowance for a 5% by-catch provision.
