The Regulations provide that transportable pressure equipment must be safe and suitable for its intended purpose and comply with the international agreements concerning transport of dangerous goods by road and rail. For purposes of the Regulations the competent authority is the Health and Safety Authority.

Where appropriate the transportable pressure equipment must be assessed by a notified body or an approved body and bear the conformity marking.

The Regulations provide for offences which are subject to summary prosecution and provide for penalties of up to €3,000 per offence.
