**EUROPEAN COMMUNITY (INTEROPERABILITY OF
 THE TRANS-EUROPEAN CONVENTIONAL RAIL
 SYSTEM) REGULATIONS 2004**

The Minister for Transport has made Regulations entitled as above under Section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972).

The purpose of these Regulations is to give effect to Council Directive 2001/16/EC of 19 March 2001 on the interoperability of the Trans-European conventional rail system. The aim of the Council Directive 2001/16/EC is to remove obstacles to interoperability on the rail lines of the Trans-European conventional rail system. Technical Specifications for interoperability (TSIs), provided for in the Directive, and agreed by Member States provide the basis for the achievement of interoperability.
