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RETAIL GROCERY AND ALLIED TRADES JOINT LABOUR COMMITTEE

Pursuant to Section 43 of the Industrial Relations Act 1946, the Labour Court hereby gives notice that it has made an Employment Regulation Order (Retail Grocery and Allied Trades Joint Labour Committee, 2004 (S.I. No. 88 of 2004)). The Order is effective from 16th March, 2004 and fixes the statutory minimum rates of pay and statutory conditions of employment of workers in relation to whom the Committee operates.
