The Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment has made the above regulations which come into effect on 4th May 2004. The Regulations give effect in Irish Law to EU Directive 2001/95/EC on General Product Safety.

The Regulations require that consumer products placed on the market are safe and oblige producers to place only safe products on the market. The Regulations specify the duties of producers and distributors and make it an offence to place dangerous products on the market. The Director of Consumer Affairs had the authority to ensure that products placed on the market are safe and that producers and distributors of such products comply with their obligations under these Regulations and the Directive.
