VESTING ORDER

Monday the 22nd day of November Two Thousand and Four

Estate of the Minister for Agriculture and Food
(formerly the Estates the Titles of which are set forth in the First Row of the Third Schedule hereto)

TO WHOM IT CONCERNS

The Revenue Commissioners hereby give notice pursuant to Section 142 of the Finance Act 2001 that on 17th day of September 2003, one Nissan Sunny motor vehicle, bearing identification mark L663KNT was seized by Officers of the Revenue Commissioners under Section 141(1) of the Finance Act 2001 on the grounds that it was liable to forfeiture under Section 139(6) of the Finance Act 1992.
