The Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform wishes to advise that he has obtained approval from the Oireachtas for the exercise by the State of the option, provided by Article 4 of the fourth Protocol set out in the Treaty of Amsterdam, to participate in the following Council Directive:

Council Directive 2001/55/EC of 20th July 2001 on minimum standards for giving temporary protection in the event of a mass influx of displaced persons and on measures promoting a balance of efforts between Member States in receiving such persons and bearing the consequences therefore.

The purpose of this Directive is to provide immediate protection and to give entitlements to persons who find themselves involved in mass influx situations. The Directive is also intended to contribute to achieving balance in the efforts to be made by Member States in addressing the situation.

New legislation is not required to transpose the Measures contained in the Council Directive as the Refugee Act 1996 provides a sufficient legislative framework for implementing the Directive.
