BLUE LING (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) (No. 3) ORDER 2004.

Prn. 3626

This Order introduces a new management regime for landings and transhipments of Blue Ling caught by Irish sea fishing boats in ICES Divisions VI and VII with effect from 7 October 2004. The Order allows Irish sea-fishing boats to land or tranship Blue Ling caught in ICES Divisions VI and VII provided that the Blue Ling may not exceed 5% by weight of the total catch of quota species landed or transhipped on any occasion. S.I. Nos. 484 of 2004 and 556 of 2004 are revoked.

HORSE MACKEREL (FISHERIES MANAGEMENT AND CONSERVATION) REGULATIONS 2004.

The effect of these Regulations is to prohibit fishing for, transhipment or having on board horse mackerel by Irish sea-fishing boats in ICES sub-areas Vb, VI, VII, VIIIa,b,d,e, XII and XIV with effect from 7 October 2004.
