 1997) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2004**

The District Court Rules Committee, with the concurrence of the Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform, has made Rules, entitled as above which amend Rule 2, sub-rules (7), (8) and (9) Order 38 of the District Court Rules 1997 (S.I. No. 93 of 1997) and prescribe procedures under section 908A of the Taxes Consolidation Act 1997, as inserted by section 207 of the Finance Act 1999 and as amended by section 68 of the Finance Act 2000, by section 132 of the Finance Act 2002 and by section 88 of the Finance Act 2004, whereby an authorised officer of the Revenue Commissioners may make application on oath and in writing to the District Court to inspect and take copies of books or records held in financial institutions where he/she suspects that there are reasonable grounds to suspect that an offence in serious prejudice to the proper assessment and collection of tax is being, or has been or is or was about to be committed and where such information is likely to be of substantial value to the investigation.
