SEA FISHERIES (WEIGHING PROCEDURES FOR
HERRING, MACKEREL AND HORSE MACKEREL)
(No. 4) REGULATIONS 2004.

These Regulations transpose into Irish law the provisions of point 12 of Annex IV of Council Regulation (EC) No. 2287/2003 which establishes weighing procedures for fishing vessels landing more than 10 tonnes of herring, mackerel and horse mackerel per landing. Masters or other persons in charge of the Irish sea-fishing boats in question will be required to give 4 hours advance notification of landings to Sea Fisheries Protection Officers. Landings in excess of 10 tonnes shall only be permitted in designated ports. These Regulations come into operation on 6 September 2004.
