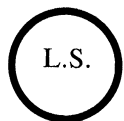
PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS ACTS 1992-2004

The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 6 of the Presidential Elections Act 1993 (No. 28 of 1993), by this his Order appoints for the purposes of the ordinary presidential election to be held in the year 2004 as follows:

1. The 1st day of October 2004 shall be the last day on which the presidential returning officer may receive nominations for the election.
2. (1) The address at which nomination papers may be delivered and to which other communications may be sent is The Presidential Returning Officer, Custom House, Dublin 1.

(2) The Custom House, Dublin 1 shall be the place at which the presidential returning officer will sit to rule upon nominations on the last day for receiving nominations.
3. The 22nd day of October 2004 shall be the day on which, and the period between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. shall be the period during which, the poll (if any) at the election shall be taken.
