This Directive lays down provisions regarding certain categories of ro-ro passenger ships and the introduction of safety requirements on passenger ships for persons with reduced mobility. These Regulations consolidate and revoke all previous Statutory Instruments transposing Directive 98/18 and amendments to it.
