CIVIL LIABILITY AND COURTS ACT 2004 (SECTION 17) ORDER 2005.

The Minister for Justice, Equality and Law Reform, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 17(7) of the Civil Liability and Courts Act 2004, has made an Order entitled as above.

For the purposes of section 17, the Order prescribes as the “prescribed date” the date upon which the personal injuries summons is served on the defendant.

- (b) in the case of the District Court, commence on the prescribed date and end on the expiration of 4 days after the delivery of a defence in those proceedings.

EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (PURITY CRITERIA ON FOOD ADDITIVES OTHER THAN COLOURS AND SWEETENERS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2005.

(This note is not part of the Instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation).

These Regulations amend the European Communities (Purity Criteria on Food Additives other than Colours and Sweeteners) Regulations 1998 (S.I. No. 541 of 1998) and may be cited as the European Communities (Purity Criteria on Food Additives other than Colours and Sweeteners) (Amendment) Regulations 2005.

These Regulations implement Commission Directive 2004/45/EC which amend the Annex to Commission Directive 96/77/EC laying down specific purity criteria on food additives other than colours and sweeteners.

They adapt, due to technical progress, existing purity criteria set out in Directive 96/77/EC and also establish new purity criteria for those food additives for which purity criteria set out in Directive 96/77/EC were not sufficient.
