MARITIME SAFETY ACT 2005 (FIXED PAYMENT NOTICES) (SECTIONS 33 AND 34) REGULATIONS 2005.

Mr. Pat the Cope Gallagher TD, Minister of State at the Department of Communications, Marine and Natural Resources, made these Regulations to prescribe the form of Notices specifying fixed payments (“on-the-spot-fines”) in lieu of prosecution, if appropriate, in relation to alleged offences under certain provisions of the Maritime Safety Act 2005 (No. 11 of 2005), namely:

section 33(3) (failure by passenger to comply with direction by master or authorised person on board passenger boat or ship) — €50 fixed payment (as prescribed by Regulation 2 of these Regulations), or

section 34(2) (failure by master or owner of a vessel to have required nautical publications on board the vessel going or attempting to go to sea or into other Irish waters) — €150 fixed payment (as set by section 27(2)(b) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1992 (No. 2 of 1992) as amended by section 47(2) of the Maritime Safety Act 2005).

Either or both amounts of fixed payment may be changed in the future by Ministerial Regulations under section 27 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1992.
