TRANSFER SCHEME

Notice is hereby given that on 6 May 2005 Tokio Marine Europe Limited ("TMEI") and Tokio Marine Global Ltd ("TMG") presented an application to the High Court of Justice in London for an order sanctioning an insurance business transfer scheme (the "Scheme") under Part VII of the United Kingdom's Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 for the transfer to TMEI of the entire general insurance and reinsurance business of TMG (excluding any policies written on or after 1 January 2005).

The Scheme was sanctioned by way of an Order given by the Honourable Mr. Justice Collins in the High Court of Justice in London on 28 July 2005. The Scheme became effective on 29 July 2005.

TMEI does not believe that policyholders holding policies with risks situated in the Republic of Ireland and which have been transferred to TMEI pursuant to the Scheme have a right to cancel their policy under Irish law as a consequence of the transfer. However, this is something which policyholders may wish to seek legal advice upon.
