The purpose of these Regulations is to give further effect to Council Directive No. 79/409/EEC of 2 April 1979 (the Birds Directive) and to Articles 6(2), (3) and (4) and Article 7 of Council Directive No. 92/43/EEC of 21 May 1992 (the Habitats Directive).

The Habitats Directive provides for the creation of a coherent European ecological network known as Natura 2000. The Habitats Directive also requires that the favourable conservation status of sites within this network is maintained. The Birds Directive provides for the conservation of wild birds by, among other things, designating important ornithological sites as Special Protection Areas as part of Natura 2000.

The effect of these Regulations is to provide for the conservation of wild birds by re-designating the above sites as Special Protection Area in accordance with Article 4 of the Birds Directive. The Regulations enhance the protective mechanisms applicable to these sites and provide that contravention of the provisions of these Regulations shall constitute an offence. The Regulations revoke previous statutory provisions classifying the sites as Special Protection Areas.
